Time expressions with in, on, at

There are three prepositions in English that are used with time **in, at, on**. Generally, **in** shows the "largest" time or place, **on** shows dates and time, and **at** usually shows the "smallest" time or place.

Preposition	Time	Example
At Use at with times	at 12:00	Brad usually eats lunch at 12:00.
	at night	They often go out at night.
Other common expressions with at	at Christmas (during a period of time around Christmas, for example, December 23rd-28th)	We visit our family and friends at Christmas.
	at the age of	I moved to California at the age of two.
	on January 18th	Pedro's birthday is on January 18th.
On Use on with dates and	on Saturday evenings	We usually stay go out on Saturday evenings.
days	on Christmas day (on December 25th)	We have a special meal on Christmas day.
In I I as in the maniful of time	in a few minutes	The bus will be leaving in a few minutes.
In Use in + a period of time = a time in the future	in five weeks also: in five weeks' time	I learned to ride a bicycle in five weeks. We will start summer vacation in five weeks' time.
	in the 1960s	The astronauts explored the moon in the 1960s.
Use in for longer periods of	in the 20th century	Automobiles and airplanes became very popular in the 20th century.
time	in December	In December, you will study less.
	in 2010	The Winter Olympics were held in Vancouver in 2010.

Note: Do not use in/at/on before "next" or "last"

We will get married **next** year. Their baby was born **last** March.
